Purpose: Provide an explanation of the criteria for the OIAH Academic Excellence Grant

Policy:

The Ohio Institute of Allied Health, Inc. (OIAH) offers grants in compliance with the State of Ohio and Board of Career Colleges and Schools.

The following criteria shall be used to clarify the rules of the award process of the Ohio Institute of Allied Health Academic Excellence Grant.

- Grants will be issued before the start of the incoming term and may be awarded for terms 2 through 4.
- Grants may only be awarded to students who have completed the essay requirements and have successfully completed the first term of the program in which they are enrolled. Students must have a minimum GPA of 3.50 for the previous term of the program.
- The grant has a value of \$2000.
- No more than \$1000 may be applied per term for full-time enrollment; no more than \$500 may be applied per term for part-time enrollment.
- The award will be posted to the student's ledger after the successful completion of each term.
- If a student withdraws, the student forfeits any remaining grant amount. The student will be required to reapply for the grant during the reapplication process.
- The grant is not a cash award and cannot be refunded to a withdrawing student.
