**National Student Loan Data System (NSLDS)**

This is a database that all schools use, including Ohio Institute of Allied Health that participates in Federal Student Aid programs. The NSLDS is a central student aid database operated by the U.S. Department of Education. NSLDS receives data from schools, agencies that guaranty loans, the Direct Loan program and other U.S. Department of Education programs. This database tracks loans and grant s from approval through to closure. NDLS is only accessible by users authorized by the U.S. Department of Education.

There is also a student access website that can give you information about your loan and/or grant. For example, loan and/or grant amounts, outstanding balances, loan statuses and disbursements. This is accessible through the following link:
